In order for your December giving to be recorded in 2020, mailed checks must have a **postmark on the envelope of no later than December 31.**

Online donations must be **received by 11:59 PM December 31.**

Reminder - \$300 charitable deduction for taxpayers who do not itemize

- You can write off up to \$300 in cash donations on your 2020 income tax return
- The \$300 can be deducted from your gross income even if you do not itemize
- The CARES Act, which went into effect this spring, established this new above-the-line deduction for charitable giving

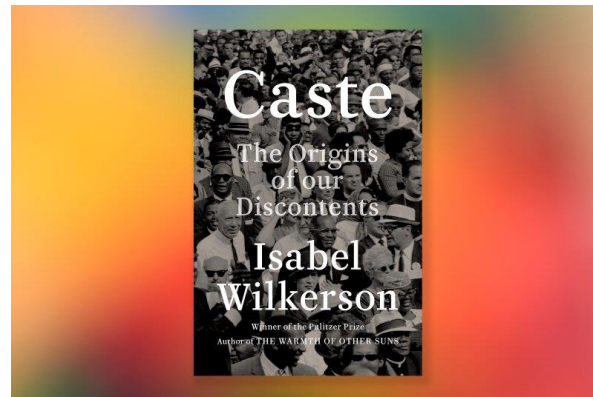
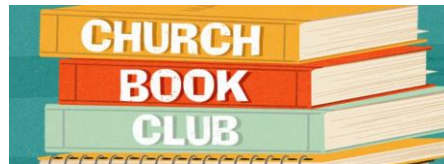
Barack Obama Elementary School.
