The money raised from our cookie sales supports the troop expenses including meeting supplies, badges, patches, activities, camping, uniforms, membership, etc.

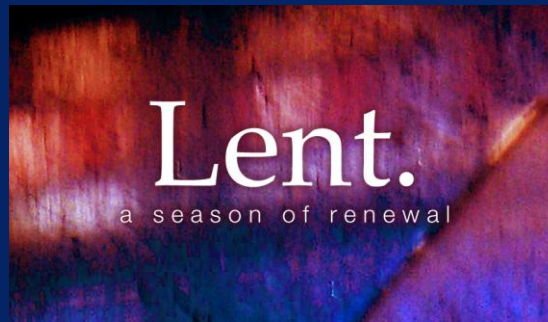
